The climate change is not just a looming crisis, but a reality on the ground. The wars of the Sudan, unremitting for nearly all its history, are explored in this study which includes an overview of history that began in Bible times; the country's main ethnicities, religions and languages; the possible causes for the wars; and the way Sudanese women are contributing to the peace process and to the culture as a whole.
